Code of Conduct

Our Goalkeeper Coaching Code of Conduct serves as a set of guidelines to ensure that coaches maintain professionalism, fairness, and respect in their dealings with players, staff, and the wider community.

1. **Respect for Players**

6. **Communication and Feedback**

- Communicate effectively with players, parents, and others involved in the team.

- Provide constructive feedback that focuses on improvement, while maintaining a positive atmosphere.

- Be clear and transparent about expectations and roles within the team or group.

7. **Respect for the Game and Officials**

- Show respect for match officials, regardless of their decisions or performance.

- Never argue with officials or engage in unsportsmanlike behavior during games or practices.

- Promote respect for the game and its traditions within the team and the wider community.

8. **Health and Safety**

- Ensure all training sessions and matches are conducted in a safe environment, following relevant regulations.

- Be aware of the signs of injury, and encourage players to report any issues.

- Ensure that proper equipment and facilities are available for all activities.

9. **Anti-Discrimination**

- Promote an inclusive environment where all players, coaches, and staff feel welcome and valued, regardless of race, gender, sexual orientation, or disability.

- Take a strong stance against any form of discrimination or harassment, both in and out of the sporting environment.

10. **Confidentiality**

- Respect the privacy of all players, staff, and their families.

- Do not disclose sensitive information unless required for safety or legal reasons.

11. **Use of Social Media**

- Be mindful of the content shared on social media, ensuring that it upholds the values and reputation of the individual, staff, team, club or group and sport.

- Avoid posting anything that could negatively affect the team or individual players.
